Applicant Information

The Professional Women in Building Council (PWB) of the Home Builders Association of Greater Charlotte (HBAGC) is dedicated to promoting, enhancing and supporting women in residential construction through advocacy, community involvement and awareness of the home building industry.

The PWB Council has established a Scholarship Program for students who are pursuing a career in the home building industry. The scholarship applies to female candidates only.

The Scholarship Program will award a limited number of \$1,000 (minimum) scholarships. These scholarships are for one year and may be renewable upon re-application and proof of successful completion of the previous year's work.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be high school seniors or undergrads within their first 3 years of college.
- Planned course study must be associated with building industry. Examples: Construction Management, Architecture, Building Science, Landscape Architecture, General Contracting, Environmental Design, Electrical/Mechanical Engineering, Masonry, Surveying, etc.
- Applicants must be officially accepted at an accredited four-year college of their choice, or an accredited two-year technical program.
- Candidates with a financial need will be given priority for consideration.

Requirements

- Application must be completed in full to be considered.
- A high school or college transcript must be submitted with the application form.
- Recommendation form must be signed and submitted with application materials.
- Deadline for application is April 15, 2026.
