

# **Habitat Update**

Gary Loflin, HBAGC long-time member and former legal counsel, passed away unexpectedly in 2016. An initiative, known as "Gary's House," was started in 2019 and through a silent auction, the HBAGC raised over \$17,000 for a Habitat for Humanity build in Gary's name. Then, as we all know, COVID hit.

In 2023, the HBAGC resumed talks with Habitat for Humanity to make the initiative a reality. We broke ground in September on a duplex located in Matthews.

Framing is complete with windows and roofing installed. All plumbing, mechanical and electric roughs have been completed and both units have been insulated. The next step is sheetrock and siding.

Gary's wife, Ellen Loflin, has been working with students at the Cannon School to plan murals and organize a build day.

We hope you will join us as a volunteer or to remember Gary at the dedication ceremony, soon to be announced.
